**Taipei Dangdai returns for its much-anticipated third edition in May 2022 with 62 galleries strongly committed to Taiwan.**

- **Two-thirds of participating galleries hail from beyond Taiwan, demonstrating the integration of Taipei into the global art market, with a significant number of international galleries exhibiting Taiwanese artists and local galleries representing well-known international artists**
- **Building on a robust foundation of online and offline programs over the past two years, the third edition of Taipei Dangdai will focus on the irreplaceable aspects of in-person exchange through Ideas Forum panels and Taipei Platform workshops as well as the growing momentum in the digital art sphere with new NFT sector Launch Stage**

**TAIPEI (5 May 2022)** - Presented by UBS, the much-anticipated third edition of Taipei Dangdai Art & Ideas returns from 20 to 22 May 2022 at Taipei World Trade Center, with a VIP Preview and Vernissage on 19 May. This edition of the Fair celebrates its identity as a regional art fair through deep relationships with art in Taiwan, as well as exploring the possibilities of innovative new technologies that have been embraced over the past two years. Bringing together 62 top-tier international galleries throughout the challenges of travel today, the Fair will offer some 1000 works by 200 artists for the Taiwanese audience in person at the physical art fair and online through a selection of digital platforms.

Robin Peckham, Taipei Dangdai Co-Director, said, “Having experienced the transformations of the art world throughout the past two years from my home here in Taipei, we have reimagined this year’s Fair as one designed and built specifically for the Taiwan market while holding ourselves to the highest standards of quality and celebrating the curiosity and innovation that belong uniquely to Taipei.”

### Highlights from the Fair

The third edition of Taipei Dangdai builds on its mission to showcase leading galleries from around the world within the context of the very best galleries from Taipei and Asia more widely. The participating galleries will show in three core sectors. In addition to the Galleries sector, Taipei Dangdai includes special sectors known as Edge, which subsidizes galleries founded within the last decade selected on the basis of their overall programming, and Solo, which spotlights singular focused presentations by living artists. Across all sectors, the two-way exchange of art and ideas to and from Taiwan is clearly evident. International galleries like LIUSA WANG (Paris) and Kiang Malingue Gallery (Hong Kong) will present leading Taiwanese artists Musquiqui Chihying and Lai Chih-Sheng, respectively, while many Taipei-based galleries, including DOPENESS ART LAB, will present respected international artists, in this case Roby Dwi Antono. Taipei Dangdai continues to build on this foundation of encouraging and promoting these deeply important patterns of exchange.

The **Galleries** sector of the fair will present premier galleries from across the world, with a predominant presence of galleries from the Asia-Pacific region. The 2022 Galleries sector welcomes a number of galleries joining the fair for the first time, including international leading galleries LGDR (New York, Paris, London, Hong Kong), Galerie EIGEN + ART (Leipzig, Berlin), SPURS Gallery (Beijing), INK studio (Beijing), and returning stalwarts like David Zwirner (New York, London, Paris, Hong Kong), SCAI The Bathhouse (Tokyo), and Esther Schipper (Berlin).

The **Edge** sector highlights and subsidizes innovative and promising galleries that have been in operation for less than a decade, encouraging them to showcase the width and breadth of their programming. This year's 7 participants include BANGKOK CITYCITY GALLERY, Double Square Gallery, Gallery COMMON, NUNU Fine Art, Galerie Julien Cadet, and 182artspace.

The **Solo** sector returns as an indisputable focus of Taipei Dangdai 2022. With a spotlight on singular focused presentations by emerging and mid-career artists, 16 participants this year include the lyrical Chinese photographer Ronghui Cheng at UP Gallery; the young painter Felix Treadwell with Carl Kostyál; and the surreal scenes of painter Charlie Roberts at Woaw Gallery.

### Highlights from the Public Programs

Taipei Dangdai announces six major features of the public program for 2022, with a dual focus on the local context in Taiwan and the expanded horizons of digital art.

According to **Taipei Dangdai Co-Director Robin Peckham**, "Proving their mettle in the never-ending search for the new, 71% of Taiwanese collectors surveyed in 2022 UBS and Art Basel Global Art Market Report said they planned to buy digital art in 2022, while only 30% said they had not sought out new artists in the past year—a low among all markets surveyed. We are excited to see these ambitious and focused collectors at the fair in person this May, many of them visiting for the first time."

### A Hybrid Model: Online/In-Person

Adding a new online sector to the Fair for 2022, **Launch Stage** invites highly curated platforms for digital art to showcase individual artist projects representative of distinct positions in the field, ranging from generative and interactive art to formal experiments and critical discourse. This year, participating platforms include Feral File, Art Blocks, Outland, and SOYL. Launch Stage will be presented across a dedicated mini-site on the Taipei Dangdai website exhibiting works from all four platforms simultaneously, and each work will be launched live from the fair in Taipei.

As a final entry in Taipei Dangdai's program of online public programs prior to the Fair, an Instagram Live discussion was held on Saturday 30 April 2022, inviting Casey Reas (Feral File), Jeff Davis (Art Blocks), and Brian Droitcour (Outland) to discuss "New Platforms for Digital Art." This panel puts the spotlight on the driving forces behind three of the top platforms for challenging, provoking, and innovative new media art today, and revealed details of Taipei Dangdai's engagement in the Space. Building on the success of **Taipei Connections** from 2020, Taipei Dangdai has continued to develop this OVR platform in order to help the gallery community connect and reconnect with the collectors and arts professionals in our audience. Taipei Dangdai has been designed and built as a regional fair, showcasing the breadth of contemporary art from around the world for Taiwan's sophisticated collectors at this year's in-person fair, while collectors from Korea, Japan, Hong Kong, and southeast Asia will gain VIP access to the fair through this online showcase. As such, the platform focuses on connections and intersections in rich editorial content, part of an ongoing program to engage galleries and guests through digital programs.

**Node**, the sector for public art, presents large-scale art with a focus on spectacular and immersive works by artists from the region, this year including projects by **Shyu Ruey-Shiann** (Double Square Gallery), **Chiu Chen Hung** (TKG+), and **Hao Jingfang and Wang Lingjie** (isArt).

**Salon** provides a platform to encourage and nurture collectors at all levels of resources and experience through a showcase of work priced below 8,000 USD from each participating gallery and functions as an on-site focal point for the Decoding Art activations that take place throughout the year in Taiwan to nurture new collectors. For 2022, Salon proudly includes affordable contributions from the full spectrum of contemporary art, from sought-after young names to established artists.

Each year Taipei Dangdai's **Ideas Forum** acts as a platform for creative ideas and thought leadership, returning in 2022 with a curated selection of talks with renowned cultural figures from Taiwan and beyond. This highly multidisciplinary program culminates over the fair's duration, featuring art industry experts as well as recognized public figures from literature, music, and philosophy. For 2022, the theme of the Ideas Forum 2022 will think through the "Escape into Understanding," the different gears that we are asked to shift through as we use lanes for dramatically different speeds in the world today: the high speed of digital communication as well as the low gears of locality that are cultivated by phenomena like lengthy quarantine policies. The title is drawn from media theorist Marshall McLuhan, who warned that "To high-speed change no adjustment is possible ... we must escape into understanding." Selected speakers include *Wild Blue Media* scholar **Melody Jue**, artist **Ashley Bickerton**, *The Membranes* novelist **Chi Ta-Wei**, artist **Timur Si-Qin**, and artist **Shu Lea Cheang**.

Returning for a second year, **Taipei Platform** consists of collaborations with partners in media and the non-profit sector, with a focus on experimental performance events and an interactive reading program. Workshops will be led by Walking Grass Agriculture, ARTouch, CANS, HAGAI, La Vie, SOYL, Pon Ding, Initium Media, OFF-SITE and FENKO Catalysis Chamber.

### About Taipei Dangdai

Taipei Dangdai is a world-class art event, providing exhibitors the opportunity to broaden their collector base and giving international exposure to a growing number of artists and galleries from across Asia. The name of the fair captures this spirit, as *dangdai* in Mandarin means “the present moment.” Held annually, Taipei Dangdai constitutes an accurate and immediate survey of what is occurring in the contemporary Asian art world. The subtitle, Art & Ideas, highlights the two main focuses of the event: a leading international art fair and a convening of thought leaders from various fields. Taipei Dangdai is a joint venture between four of the world’s leading art event producers, organizers, and administrators: Single Market Events (Tim Etchells), Angus Montgomery Limited (Sandy Angus), Ramsay Fairs Limited (Will Ramsay), and ARTHQ / EVENTS Limited (Magnus Renfrew). Presented by UBS, the fair is overseen by Co-Directors Magnus Renfrew and Robin Peckham, and the third edition takes place at Taipei World Trade Center, Hall 1 from Friday 20 until Sunday 22 May 2022 with a VIP Preview and Vernissage on 19 May.

Taipei Dangdai is part of The Art Assembly, an affiliation of major international art fairs with a particular focus on the Asia Pacific region comprising Taipei Dangdai, India Art Fair, Sydney Contemporary, PHOTOFAIRS Shanghai and the forthcoming ArtSG. It represents a joint initiative between three of the world’s leading art fair organisers headed by Sandy Angus, Tim Etchells and Magnus Renfrew.
